

## **DR. SARAH NTIRO NYENDWOHA.**

- She was the 1st Woman University Graduate in East and Central Africa.
- Graduated from Oxford University with a BA (Hon) in History in 1954.
- Protested for not getting equal Salary Scale in 1955 with her Male Graduate counter-parts while teaching at Gayaza High School.
- The Wife of the Colonial Governor upon interesting her agreed with, her protest and the matter was pursued with the colonial Government and was permitted to receive equal Salary.
- Taught in Kyebambe Girls S.S between 1950-1951.
- One of the first two African women members of Uganda Legislative Council 1958-1961.
- Got Married in 1958 to Prof. I. Ntiro of Tanzania.
- Was a member of the three separate delegations from Uganda to UN General Assembly.
- She started the Teaching Service Committee now the Education Service Commission when she worked in the Ministry of Education 1965- 1967.
- Worked in Office of the Vice Chancellor Makerere University 1970-1978.
- She is credited for being the first to cut the narrow trail of University education that has now become a high way of opportunities for Uganda girls and Women.
